In light of this tragic event, the Gardena Police Department would like to remind its community to always be alert and prepared in case of an active shooter event. It is equally important to always be aware of your surroundings and report any suspicious activity immediately, "If you see something, say something."

An active shooter is an individual actively engaged in killing or attempting to kill people in a confined and populated area. Victims are selected at random and the location in which active shooter events occur are unpredicta-

Run. Hide. Fight. Surviving an Active Shooter Event

When law enforcement arrives:

- Remain calm and follow instructions.
- Put down any items in your hands. (i.e., bags, jackets)
- Raise hands and spread fingers.
- Keep hands visible at all times.
- Avoid quick movements towards officers such as holding on to them for safety.
- Avoid pointing, screaming or yelling.
- Do not stop to ask officers for help or direction when evacuating.

Information you should provide to law enforcement or 911 operators:

- Location of the active shooter.
- Number of shooters.
- Physical description of shooters.
- Number and type of weapons held by shooters.
- Number of potential victims at the location.

How to respond when an active shooter is in your vicinity:

1. <u>RU</u>N

Have an escape route and plan in mind.

Leave your belongings behind.

Keep your hands visible.

Call 911 when you are safe.

2. HIDE

Hide in an area out of the shooter's view.

Block entry to your hiding place and lock the door.


Silence your cell phone (including vibrate mode) and remain quiet.

3. FIGHT

Hide as a last resort and only when your life is in imminent danger.

Attempt to incapacitate the shooter.

Act with physical aggression and improvise weapons or throw items at the active shooter.

His favorite memory as Detective was when a jury would read a "Guilty" verdict on a murder in court and watching the victim's family express the feeling of relief because they knew the suspect would not ever get out




